¹ And it came to pass...that Elijah went with Elisha from Gilgal.

¹¹ Then it happened, as they continued on and talked, that suddenly a chariot of fire *appeared* with horses of fire, and separated the two of them; and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven. ¹² And Elisha saw *it*, and he cried out, “My father, my father, the chariot of Israel and its horsemen!” So he saw him no more...

Luke 9:28-31 (Expanded Bible, EXB)

²⁸ About eight days after Jesus said these things, he took Peter, John, and James and went up on a mountain to pray. ²⁹ While Jesus was praying, the appearance of his face ·changed [was altered], and his clothes became shining white [*or* flashed white like lightning]. ³⁰ Then [^Llook; ^Tbehold] two men, Moses and Elijah, were talking with Jesus. [^CGod had given the Law through Moses, and Elijah was an important prophet (see 9:8); together they signify that Jesus fulfills the OT.] ³¹ They appeared in heavenly glory [^Lglory], talking about his departure [^CGreek: *exodos*, perhaps recalling the Exodus from Egypt, and referring to Jesus’ death, resurrection, and ascension] which he would soon bring about [^Lwas about to fulfill/accomplish] in Jerusalem.

Revelation 11:1-3,5-6 (NIV)

¹ I was given a reed like a measuring rod and was told, “Go and measure the temple of God and the altar, with its worshipers. ² But exclude the outer court; do not measure it, because it has been given to the Gentiles. They will trample on the holy city for 42 months. ³ And I will appoint my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for 1,260 days, clothed in sackcloth.”

$$\frac{1,260 \text{ days}}{30 \text{ days per month}} = 42 \text{ months}$$

$$\frac{42 \text{ months}}{12 \text{ months per year}} = 3\frac{1}{2} \text{ years}$$

⁵ If anyone tries to harm them, fire comes from their mouths and devours their enemies. This is how anyone who wants to harm them must die. ⁶ They have power to shut up the heavens so that it will not rain during the time they are prophesying; and they have power to turn the waters into blood and to strike the earth with every kind of plague as often as they want.

¹⁴ Enoch was the seventh man in the family line of Adam. He gave a prophecy about these people. He said, “Look! The Lord is coming with thousands and thousands of his holy ones. ¹⁵ He is coming to judge everyone. He is coming to sentence all of them. He will judge them for all the ungodly acts they have done. They have done them in ungodly ways. He will sentence ungodly sinners for all the things they have said to oppose him.”
