

### Matthew 18:15-18,21-22 (NRSV)

#### **Reproving Another Who Sins**

<sup>15</sup> "If another member of the church sins against you, go and point out the fault when the two of you are alone. If the member listens to you, you have regained that one. <sup>16</sup> But if you are not listened to, take one or two others along with you, so that every word may be confirmed by the evidence of two or three witnesses. <sup>17</sup> If the member refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church; and if the offender refuses to listen even to the church, let such a one be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector. <sup>18</sup> Truly I tell you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.

#### **Forgiveness**

<sup>21</sup> Then Peter came and said to him, "Lord, if another member of the church sins against me, how often should I forgive? As many as seven times?" <sup>22</sup> Jesus said to him, "Not seven times, but, I tell you, seventy-seven times.

## **Luke 17:3-4 (NRSV)**

<sup>3</sup> Be on your guard! If another disciple<sup>[a]</sup> sins, you must rebuke the offender, and if there is repentance, you must forgive. <sup>4</sup> And if the same person sins against you seven times a day, and turns back to you seven times and says, 'I repent,' you must forgive."

## **Galatians 5:22–6:3,7-10 (NRSV)**

#### The Fruit of the Spirit

<sup>22</sup> ...the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against such things. <sup>24</sup> And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. <sup>25</sup> If we live by the Spirit, let us also be guided by the Spirit. <sup>26</sup> Let us not become conceited, competing against one another, envying one another.

#### **Bear One Another's Burdens**

<sup>1</sup> My friends, if anyone is detected in a transgression, you who have received the Spirit should restore such a one in a spirit of gentleness. Take care that you yourselves are not tempted. <sup>2</sup> Bear one another's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ. <sup>3</sup> For if those who are nothing think they are something, they deceive themselves. ...

<sup>7</sup> Do not be deceived; God is not mocked, for you reap whatever you sow. <sup>8</sup> If you sow to your own flesh, you will reap corruption from the flesh; but if you sow to the Spirit, you will reap eternal life from the Spirit. <sup>9</sup> So let us not grow weary in doing what is right, for we will reap at harvest time, if we do not give up. <sup>10</sup> So then, whenever we have an opportunity, let us work for the good of all, and especially for those of the family of faith.

### 1 Timothy 5:17-21 (NRSV)

<sup>17</sup> Let the elders who rule well be considered worthy of double honor, <sup>[a]</sup> especially those who labor in preaching and teaching; <sup>18</sup> for the scripture says, "You shall not muzzle an ox while it is treading out the grain," and, "The laborer deserves to be paid." <sup>19</sup> Never accept any accusation against an elder except on the evidence of two or three witnesses. <sup>20</sup> As for those who persist in sin, rebuke them in the presence of all, so that the rest also may stand in fear. <sup>21</sup> In the presence of God and of Christ Jesus and of the elect angels, I warn you to keep these instructions without prejudice, doing nothing on the basis of partiality.

## 1 Corinthians 5:9-13 (NRSV)

#### Sexual Immorality Must Be Judged

<sup>9</sup>I wrote to you in my letter not to associate with sexually immoral persons—<sup>10</sup> not at all meaning the immoral of this world, or the greedy and robbers, or idolaters, since you would then need to go out of the world. <sup>11</sup> But now I am writing to you not to associate with anyone who bears the name of brother or sister who is sexually immoral or greedy, or is an idolater, reviler, drunkard, or robber. Do not even eat with such a one. <sup>12</sup> For what have I to do with judging those outside? Is it not those who are inside that you are to judge? <sup>13</sup> God will judge those outside. "Drive out the wicked person from among you."

## 2 Corinthians 2:5-11 (NRSV)

#### Forgiveness for the Offender

<sup>5</sup>But if anyone has caused pain, he has caused it not to me, but to some extent—not to exaggerate it—to all of you. <sup>6</sup>This punishment by the majority is enough for such a person; <sup>7</sup> so now instead you should forgive and console him, so that he may not be overwhelmed by excessive sorrow. <sup>8</sup>So I urge you to reaffirm your love for him. <sup>9</sup>I wrote for this reason: to test you and to know whether you are obedient in everything. <sup>10</sup>Anyone whom you forgive, I also forgive. What I have forgiven, if I have forgiven anything, has been for your sake in the presence of Christ. <sup>11</sup>And we do this so that we may not be outwitted by Satan; for we are not ignorant of his designs.

## 2 Corinthians 6:14-18 (NRSV)

#### The Temple of the Living God

<sup>14</sup> Do not be mismatched with unbelievers. For what partnership is there between righteousness and lawlessness? Or what fellowship is there between light and darkness? <sup>15</sup> What agreement does Christ have with Beliar? Or what does a believer share with an unbeliever? <sup>16</sup> What agreement has the temple of God with idols? For we<sup>[a]</sup> are the temple of the living God; as God said,

"I will live in them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and they shall be my people.

17 Therefore come out from them, and be separate from them, says the Lord, and touch nothing unclean; then I will welcome you, 18 and I will be your father, and you shall be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty."
