



Q	1. Are Enoch and Elijah the last two witnesses in Revelation?	
Q	2. Did they go to heaven then come back to lay their bodies down (it is once for all to die)?	
Q	3. The fleshly body cannot enter Heaven, so how were they there?	
Re	eview of Part 1 (Revelation 11:1-3,5-6)	
1.	. The mission of God's two witnesses lasts 3½ years (or 42 months, or 1,260 days). While they prophesy about God's coming judgment, they can do miracles like stopping it from raining.	
2.	The case for Enoch: He prophesied about God coming judgment. Enoch was translated.	
3.	The case for Hijah: He made it stop raining for 3½ years. Elijah was taken up by a whirlwind into heaven, with a chariot and horses of fire involved.	
	"it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment" (Hebrews 9:27 KJV)	
	The Two Witnesses do eventually die (Revelation 11:7-12,18) before God's wrath is unleashed. Their dead bodies lay in the streets of for 3½ days before they are raised to life and ascend into heaven.

5.	A mortal human body cannot exist in Heaven. We receive abody (like the one Jesus has) at the time of the rapture.	
6.	. The Two Witnesses are, so they must still have a mortal human body during their mission. They couldn't have gone to heaven and came back.	
7.	The prophet Zechariah (520 to 518 B.C) with John (c. 95 A.D.) as he was measuring the city of Jerusalem as it exists in the 21 st century.

8	The Jews were expecting Elijah to return, but said he already had.

¹⁹ He replied, "I will cause all my goodness to pass before you... ²⁰ But my face," he continued, "you cannot see, because a human being cannot look at me and remain alive.

1 Corinthians 15:49-53 (NIRV)

⁴⁹ We are like the earthly man. And we will be like the heavenly man.

⁵Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord: ⁶And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse.

Matthew 17:9-13 (NIRV)

⁹They came down the mountain. On the way down, Jesus told them what to do. "Don't tell anyone what you have seen," he said. "Wait until the Son of Man has been raised from the dead."

¹⁰ The disciples asked him, "Why do the teachers of the law say that Elijah has to come first?"

- ⁷ And when they shall have finished their testimony, the beast that ascendeth out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them.
- ⁸ And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.
- ⁹ And they of the people and kindreds and tongues and nations shall see their dead bodies three days and an half, and shall not suffer their dead bodies to be put in graves.
- ¹⁰ And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.
- ¹¹ And after three days and an half the spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood upon their feet; and great fear fell upon them which saw them.
- ¹² And they heard a great voice from heaven saying unto them, Come up hither. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them.
- ¹⁸ And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth.

Zechariah 2:1-5 (NIV)

¹ Then I looked up, and there before me was a man with a measuring line in his hand. ² I asked, "Where are you going?"

He answered me, "To measure Jerusalem, to find out how wide and how long it is."

³ While the angel who was speaking to me was leaving, another angel came to meet him ⁴ and said to him: "Run, tell that young man, 'Jerusalem will be a city without walls because of the great number of people and animals in it. ⁵ And I myself will be a wall of fire around it,' declares the LORD, 'and I will be its glory within.'

Zechariah 4:1-3,11,14 (NIV)

¹ Then the angel who talked with me returned and woke me up, like someone awakened from sleep. ² He asked me, "What do you see?" I answered, "I see a solid gold lampstand with a bowl at the top and seven lamps on it, with seven channels to the lamps. ³ Also there are two olive trees by it, one on the right of the bowl and the other on its left."

¹¹ Then I asked the angel, "What are these two olive trees on the right and the left of the lampstand?"

¹⁴ So he said, "These are the two who are anointed to serve the Lord of all the earth."

Revelation 11:1-6 (NIV)

¹ I was given a reed like a measuring rod and was told, "Go and measure the temple of God and the altar, with its worshipers.

² But exclude the outer court; do not measure it, because it has been given to the Gentiles. They will trample on the holy city for 42 months. ³ And I will appoint my two witnesses, and they will prophesy for 1,260 days, clothed in sackcloth."

⁴ They are "the two olive trees" and the two lampstands, and "they stand before the Lord of the earth." ⁵ If anyone tries to harm them, fire comes from their mouths and devours their enemies. This is how anyone who wants to harm them must die. ⁶ They have power to shut up the heavens so that it will not rain during the time they are prophesying; and they have power to turn the waters into blood and to strike the earth with every kind of plague as often as they want.
