

W	Vords of Comfort Matthew 9:18-19,23-25 John 11:23-25 John 6:40,44,54 1 Thessalonians 4:13-14,16-18 1 Corinthians 15:52,55
1.	When Jairus' daughter died, Jesus told everyone she was only He said the same thing when Lazarus died (John 11:1-44). Jesus raised them both.
2.	Lazarus' sister Martha understood the resurrection was on the, because Jesus had been teaching this to his disciples.
3.	Paul taught us not to grieve for those who are dead, because we have in the resurrection. It doesn't matter how long we are in the grave: God gives us the victory!
W	There Some People Look for Comfort Revelation 20:4-7,10-13,15 Luke 16:19-24
4.	Two scripture are used as the basis of a doctrine that says you go to Heaven or Hell when you die: (a) Lazarus and the rich man, and (b) "to be absent from the body [is] to be present with the Lord" (next time, to answer Q4).

Matthew 9:18-19,23-25 (NCV) (Same as Mark 5:22-24,35-43)

¹⁸ While Jesus was saying these things, a leader of the synagogue came to him. He bowed down before Jesus and said, "My daughter has just died. But if you come and lay your hand on her, she will live again." ¹⁹ So Jesus and his followers stood up and went with the leader.

²³ Jesus continued along with the leader and went into his house. There he saw the funeral musicians and many people crying. ²⁴ Jesus said, "Go away. The girl is not dead, only asleep." But the people laughed at him. ²⁵ After the crowd had been thrown out of the house, Jesus went into the girl's room and took hold of her hand, and she stood up.

John 11:23-25 (NCV)

²³ Jesus said, "Your brother will rise and live again." ²⁴ Martha answered, "I know that he will rise and live again in the resurrection on the last day." ²⁵ Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in me will have life even if they die."

John 6:39-40,44,54 (NASB)

- ³⁹ And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that of everything that He has given Me I will lose nothing, but will raise it up on the last day. ⁴⁰ For this is the will of My Father, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him will have eternal life, and I Myself will raise him up on the last day."
- ⁴⁴ No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him; and I will raise him up on the last day.
- ⁵⁴ The one who eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-14,16-18 (AMP)

¹³ Now we do not want you to be uninformed, believers, about those who are asleep [in death], so that you will not grieve [for them] as the others do who have no hope [beyond this present life]. ¹⁴ For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again [as in fact He did], even so God [in this same way—by raising them from the dead] will bring with Him those [believers] who have fallen asleep in Jesus.

¹⁶ For the Lord Himself will come down from heaven with a shout of command, with the voice of the archangel and with the [blast of the] trumpet of God, and the dead in Christ will rise... ¹⁷ ...in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and...will always be with the Lord! ¹⁸ Therefore comfort *and* encourage one another...

1 Corinthians 15:52,55 (NKJV)

⁵² In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

Revelation 20:4-6 (KJV)

⁴...and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years. ⁵But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. ⁶Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years.

Revelation 20:7,10-13,15 (KJV)

⁷And when the thousand years are expired, ... ¹⁰...the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire... and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever. ¹¹And I saw a great white throne, ... ¹²And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; ... ¹³...and they were judged every man according to their works. ¹⁵And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.


Luke 16:19-24 (NIRV)

¹⁹ "Once there was a rich man. … He lived an easy life every day. ²⁰ …Lazarus was a beggar… ²¹ … All he wanted was to eat what fell from the rich man's table.

²² "The time came when the beggar died. The angels carried him to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried. ²³ In the place of the dead, the rich man was suffering terribly. He looked up and saw Abraham far away. Lazarus was by his side. ²⁴ So the rich man called out, 'Father Abraham! Have pity on me! Send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water. Then he can cool my tongue with it. I am in terrible pain in this fire.'
