### Revelation 15:1

<sup>1</sup> I saw in heaven another great and marvelous sign: seven angels with the seven last plagues—last, because with them God’s wrath is completed.

### Revelation 8:1-2,6

<sup>1</sup> When he opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour. <sup>2</sup> And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and seven trumpets were given to them.

<sup>6</sup> Then the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared to sound them.

## Revelation 9:1-12

<sup>1</sup> The fifth angel sounded his trumpet, and I saw a star that had fallen from the sky to the earth. The star was given the key to the shaft of the Abyss. <sup>2</sup> When he opened the Abyss, smoke rose from it like the smoke from a gigantic furnace. The sun and sky were darkened by the smoke from the Abyss. <sup>3</sup> And out of the smoke locusts came down on the earth and were given power like that of scorpions of the earth. <sup>4</sup> They were told not to harm the grass of the earth or any plant or tree, but only those people who did not have the seal of God on their foreheads. <sup>5</sup> They were not allowed to kill them but only to torture them for five months. And the agony they suffered was like that of the sting of a scorpion when it strikes. <sup>6</sup> During those days people will seek death but will not find it; they will long to die, but death will elude them.

<sup>7</sup> The locusts looked like horses prepared for battle. On their heads they wore something like crowns of gold, and their faces resembled human faces. <sup>8</sup> Their hair was like women's hair, and their teeth were like lions' teeth. <sup>9</sup> They had breastplates like breastplates of iron, and the sound of their wings was like the thundering of many horses and chariots rushing into battle.

<sup>10</sup> They had tails with stingers, like scorpions, and in their tails they had power to torment people for five months.

<sup>2</sup> a day of darkness and gloom,  
a day of clouds and blackness.  
Like dawn spreading across the mountains  
a large and mighty army comes,  
such as never was in ancient times  
nor ever will be in ages to come.

<sup>3</sup> Before them fire devours,  
behind them a flame blazes.  
Before them the land is like the garden of Eden,  
behind them, a desert waste—  
nothing escapes them.

<sup>4</sup> They have the appearance of horses;  
they gallop along like cavalry.

<sup>5</sup> With a noise like that of chariots  
they leap over the mountaintops,  
like a crackling fire consuming stubble,  
like a mighty army drawn up for battle.

<sup>6</sup> At the sight of them, nations are in anguish;  
every face turns pale.

<sup>7</sup> They charge like warriors;  
they scale walls like soldiers.  
They all march in line,  
not swerving from their course.

<sup>8</sup> They do not jostle each other;  
each marches straight ahead.  
They plunge through defenses  
without breaking ranks.

<sup>9</sup> They rush upon the city;  
they run along the wall.

They climb into the houses;  
like thieves they enter through the windows.

<sup>10</sup> Before them the earth shakes,  
the heavens tremble,  
the sun and moon are darkened,  
and the stars no longer shine.

<sup>11</sup> The Lord thunders  
at the head of his army;  
his forces are beyond number,  
and mighty is the army that obeys his command.

The day of the Lord is great;  
it is dreadful.  
Who can endure it?
